# RISK ASSESSMENT FOR CONGREGANTS: SHOULD I ATTEND CHURCH?

## A. High Risk Questions

Have you tested positive for Covid 19 in the last 14 days?

 

Are you obese or do you have Diabetes?

 

Have you had a sore throat, fever or cough, loss of taste or smell in the past 14 days?

 

Have you been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid 19, or has had flu like symptoms, in the last 14 days?

 

Do you have a mask to wear to church?

 

**IF you have said yes to any of the questions you are high risk so we strongly recommend you do not attend church. Rather attend online services or practice home worship.**

## B. Risk Questions

Are you above the age of 65?

 

Do you have any pre-existing medical conditions such as TB, HIV, asthma or heart disease?

 

Are you a health care worker, or do you work in a health care facility?

 

Do you live with a health care worker or someone who works in a health care facility?

 

Do you live with some who is above the age 65 or has a pre-existing medical condition?

 

**IF you have said yes to any of the questions you are at increased risk. If you do want to attend church then make sure you practice social distancing, wear a mask and wash hands frequently when attending church.**
